



Pre-Registration 2010 - 2011

Dear Member,

The Mount Bruno Curling Club regularly experiences an increase of 25 members per year, but loses an equal number by attrition each year. Since the Club wishes to operate with a full compliment of members, and because of budget operation expenses, the directors have decided to maintain the compulsory pre-registration for members for the 2010–2011 curling season. Futhermore, we encourage you to register a new member or two to help reach a goal of 250 members, and play an active role in bringing in a group to rent our facilities, thus enabling us to maintain reasonable registration fees.

The management of league registration has become more and more complex. We must provide volunteer members responsible for the management of registrations with the tools required to facilitate their work and maintain adequate quality services for members. In order to meet this objective, we request that members respect these policies.

Please note that all curling club members of 2009–2010 must use the new registration procedure. **Pre-registration is the only way available to insure a place in night or day league curling in 2010–2011.**

After April 17th, 2010 and the organization of pre-registrations, the applications of individuals wishing to become new members will be considered. The official results will be announced during the annual shareholders meeting of June 8th 2010. Presently, no changes are expected to the schedules of night leagues. However, the games for seniors and activities for juniors may be subject to changes if the needs of the club so dictate.

The pre–registration procedure is subject to the policy relating to the number of leagues in which a member can participate. This policy of <<2+1>> allows a member to choose to register in two night leagues only. A third choice will be granted if the member registers for the development league on Saturday morning or if places are available in the night league of their third choice.

Our objective is to increase our membership up to its full capacity. This is why even if several individuals have expressed an interest in becoming members for 2010–2011, we ask you to provide us with the names of persons wishing to become a member, so they can be added to the priority list.

PRE-REGISTRATION PROCEDURES FOR REGULAR MEMBERS SEASON 2010-2011

- All members must complete the pre-inscription form on the computer at the club.
- The period for pre-registration is be from March 15th to April 17th 2010.
- Volunteers will be on hand to assist you to complete the form.
- **A cheque for \$75.00 dated no later than April 17th, 2010 or \$75 in cash in an envelope bearing your name must be deposited in the slot of the club office door to validate your pre-registration.**

PROCEDURES OF REGISTRATION OF NEW MEMBERS FOR 2010-2011

- Complete the registration form.
- Give the completed form to a member of the Executive Committee or at the bar.
- Attach to the form a \$75 cheque or \$75 in cash in an envelope bearing your name.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- The number of places in each league is limited.
- For each league, priority will be given to members who played in that league the previous year.
- Only duly completed forms accompanied by a cheque or cash will be considered.
- **Cheques are to made out in the order of <<Mount Bruno Curling Club>> and will be cashed the first week of May 2010.**

REIMBURSEMENT

- Reimbursement will only be given in exceptional circumstances like moving, illness, injury or any other important reason.

PRODUCTS OFFERED – LEAGUES

- Our registration policies and league structures are made to respond to the needs of the Mount Bruno Curling Club membership by offering quality curling to members' skill level and availability.

LEAGUES (NIGHT)

- Accessible to members who have paid their dues.
- Teams can consider the possibility of a 5th player on a team (must be a member).
- Replacement of players is managed by the person responsible for the league.
- All games are 8 ends starting at 6:50p.m. & 9:00 p.m.
- The format of the playoffs is organized by each league director and the executive director of leagues.
- Juniors who wish to play in night leagues must be registered as student members and be 18 years of age as of December 31, 2010. They must be 16 years of age and over as of December 31, 2010 if they play on the same team with at least one of their parents. Two exceptions will be made for competition teams who play in a league as a team.

A) League Seigneurial

- a. 24 teams maximum
- b. No byes
- c. Monday night 6:50 pm and 9:00 pm for divisions A & B
- d. Wednesday night 6:50 pm and 9:00 pm for divisions C & D

B) League Montarville

- a. 15 teams maximum
- b. Possibility of a bye
- c. Tuesday night at 6:50 pm & 9:00 pm

C) League Beaumont

- a. 15 teams maximum
- b. Possibility of a bye
- c. Thursday night at 6:50 pm & 9:00 pm

D) League Oakwood (mixed – 2 men 2 women alternating)

- a. 15 teams maximum
- b. Possibility of a bye
- c. Friday night at 6:50 pm & 9:00 pm

LEAGUES (DAY)

E) League Clairevue and League Rabastalière

- a. League Rabastalière on Monday morning at 8:50 am & 11:00 am.
- b. League Clairevue on Wednesday morning at 8:50 am & 11:00 am.
- c. Possibility of byes or games scheduled another day of the week
- d. Those interested in competing in the Interclub League on Fridays must pre-register. The number of registrations will determine the number of Fridays a member will play.

Developmental Leagues

F) League Juniors

- a. Times for practicing and playing will be determined by a committee created for this purpose.
- b. Most activities will occur on Sunday mornings.

G) League Crystal

- a. This is an entry league for people interested in becoming members of the club.
- b. Open to members at a \$5 cost and at \$12.00 per game for non-members which includes the cost of the crystal glasses.
- c. A schedule will be made at the beginning of the year according to the number of teams and the calendar of events of the club.
- d. Participants pay on a per-game basis to the director of the league.
- e. There is a possibility that non-members can give their names for replacement in night or day leagues providing they pay \$15.00 per game which will be given to the skip.
- f. 12 team maximum and no byes.
- g. Saturday at 10:00 am to 12:15 pm with games of 8 ends.
- h. Instructional time will be provided for new curlers, especially at the beginning of the year with practice times scheduled according to demand.
